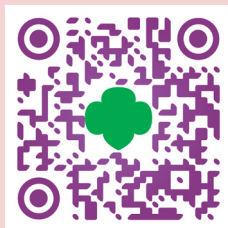
Earn Points • Receive Rewards

| 20 Put up a Girl Scout road sign on your lawn | 50 Place five Girl Scout road signs locally |
| 30 Post a flyer about a recruitment event or council activity on a community group | 100 Help at a council recruitment event |
| 30 Post a flyer about a recruitment event or council activity on a school or PTO page | 150 Add a new girl to your troop |
| 30 Get a flyer distributed to class (paper or digital copy) | 150 Encourage your troop to wear their uniforms to school (take a picture and post on Facebook) |
| 30 Get a flyer approved to be posted on a school website | 200 Add a new volunteer to your troop |
| 30 Submit an article to the council enewsletter | 250 Refer a new volunteer to join Girl Scouts |
| 30 Put up a Girl Scout road sign at a business | 300 Host a Girl Scout recruitment event/drive thru, either virtual or in-person, for girls or adults (plan, script and supplies provided by council) |
| 30 Put out Girl Scouts flyers at a local business or library | 500 Get a new troop started (minimum of five girls and two adults) |
