

JULIETTE LOW SEMINAR 2019 – NATIONAL FACILITATOR APPLICATION

Girl Scouts of the USA is seeking applications from members of the Global Leadership Opportunities (GLO) pool and National Volunteer Partners (NVPs) to serve as a National Facilitator at the 2019 Juliette Low Seminar.

The Juliette Low Seminar aims to empower up to 1,000 WAGGGS members with the leadership practices, global perspectives and peer support network to take the lead in their lives and act on their values to bring positive social change to their world. The programme will focus on empowering members aged 20-30 to develop their leadership practice, understand and tackle gender barriers to leadership, and participate in decision making. Each participant will be expected to work with their Association to empower at least 100 younger Girl Guides and Girl Scouts with leadership practices following the seminar. *At the GSUSA hub, participants from the United States can be Ambassador Girl Scouts, age 18 or older.*

National Facilitators: will be selected by GSUSA and trained online in the JLS programme by their International Facilitator counterparts. From January–October 2019, National Facilitators and International facilitators will work together virtually to adapt the programme to their local context and prepare to deliver it at our hub location.

November 14-20	Facilitate at Juliette Low Seminar
November 20	Evaluation
November – December 2019	Complete the evaluation document assessing the outcome of the Juliette Low Seminar.
