

## JULIETTE LOW SEMINAR 2019 – NATIONAL SERVICE TEAM APPLICATION

Girl Scouts of the USA is seeking applications from members of the Global Leadership Opportunities (GLO) pool and National Volunteer Partners (NVPs) to serve as on the National Service Team for the 2019 Juliette Low Seminar.

The Juliette Low Seminar aims to empower up to 1,000 WAGGGS members with the leadership practices, global perspectives and peer support network to take the lead in their lives and act on their values to bring positive social change to their world. The programme will focus on empowering members aged 20-30 to develop their leadership practice, understand and tackle gender barriers to leadership, and participate in decision making. Each participant will be expected to work with their Association to empower at least 100 younger Girl Guides and Girl Scouts with leadership practices following the seminar. *At the GSUSA hub, participants from the United States can be Ambassador Girl Scouts, age 18 or older.*

**Head of Logistics** will lead the National Service Team and serve as the main point of contact for the WAGGGS team organizing the JLS, as well as for the programme team, in partnership with GSUSA staff. This person must be on site for the entire programme to provide support to participants and manage the national service team. This role will oversee all pre-event communications with participants, including coordinating VISA endorsement letters. This role will also manage risk throughout the programme.

**The National Service Team** will be selected by GSUSA and will be responsible for organizing and running the JLS hub event, including handling communication with participants. Members of the team must also be available during the event to support the head of logistics and programme team. *Members of this team cannot also serve as National Facilitators.*

**Time Commitment:**

January – November 2019	Preparation for event, carried out virtually with other programmed team members (approx. 2 hours per week)
November 13-21	Support logistics at Juliette Low Seminar
November – December 2019	Debrief and evaluate the outcome of the Juliette Low Seminar.
