Volunteer Years of Service Pin		Volunteer Years of Service recognizes years of <u>active service</u> to the Girl Scout organization as an adult. Given for 5 and 10 years of service at a regional awards event and 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 50, and 60 years of service at council awards event. This pin can be requested by the recipient or another person. For those with no activity at the regional level, this pin will be given at the Council awards event. Regional Good Neighbor		Recognizes community members who are not registered in Girl Scouts, such as a group, business or individual, whose service has contributed directly to a community or region. Certificate of Appreciation		Recognizes outstanding completion of a designated task that supports Girl Scouting in a community and/or region by an adult member.	Online Regional Nomination form with <u>one</u> endorsement name	No limit	No limit
Star Rookie		Recognizes the first-year troop/group leader who has made the most significant contribution to the community. Candidate is a registered adult member, fulfills troop leader responsibilities per position description, completed all required training. Rising Star		Recognizes an outstanding new volunteer during her/his first three years, for services beyond the expectations of the position, contributing outstanding service while engaging girls in Girl Scouting. Candidate is registered and background checked by GSJS. Completed appropriate training for the role. Can be leader or troop volunteer. Can be given once in the first 36 months as a volunteer. Outdoor Pathfinder		Recognizes a volunteer who facilitates a full day or overnight outdoor experience at the community or regional level. Growing In Girl Scouts		Recognizes a volunteer who grows membership by running an event for the region or community for the first time, which results in new members. Soaring High		Recognizes significant contributions of an adult member to the advancement of the Girl Scout program within the community for outstanding completion of a designated task. Candidate is a registered adult member, completed all required training, has multiple commitments to the community for the current membership year. Open Arms		Recognizes a leader who accepts more girls into her/his troop. - Grades K-5 : by having the GSUSA recommended troop size (12) and adding at least one more girl into the troop. - Grades 6-12 : by increasing your troops size from the previous year. Candidate is a registered and background checked leader. Has completed training required for the role. Can be given once per level. Juliette Low Award		Recognizes a volunteer who has made significant contributions to the community. Candidate is a registered leader for at least three years, has attended a majority of community meetings, candidate's troop has participated in at least one community, regional or council event, and has served in an additional volunteer capacity (other than leader). Hats Off		Recognizes a volunteer who is both a leader of multiple troops or multi-level troop and a volunteer in the community or region and provides girl programs to girls in the community or region. Regional Award [design varies by region and year]		Recognizes one individual member of each Regional Committee for outstanding support and service to the Regional Committee Chairperson. Graduating Leader		Recognizes a troop leader of two or more girls in twelfth grade from any level. This pin can be requested by the recipient or another person.	Online Regional Nomination form. <i>May be self-nominated</i>	No limit	As earned
Super 13 Graduating Leader		Recognizes a leader who stayed with girl members of a troop continuously from kindergarten to twelfth grade. Candidate is registered Troop leader for minimum of 13 years. Legacy Award		Recognizes a longtime volunteer that has performed a significant task within the community for at least ten years and continues to volunteer in some capacity within the community. Outstanding Volunteer		Recognizes a registered adult member in a position other than leader or in addition to being a leader whose service benefits a community or region in a way that is beyond expectations. Outstanding Leader		Recognizes a troop/group leader/coordinator whose performance in working with the girls is so outstanding that it merits recognition by the region. Candidate is registered adult leader, completed training, and demonstrated competence in girl-adult partnership, communication, membership development, pluralism and program delivery, work with girls has exceeded expectations for the position in position description. Volunteer of Excellence		Recognizes a volunteer who has contributed outstanding service while partnering directly with girls and/or adults using the national program portfolio. Sustained Service		Recognizes a volunteer who continues to provide outstanding service to the girls, community, or region. Candidate is registered and background checked member of GSJS.
