- Coordinates distribution of Annual Giving Information to community coordinator
- Oversees distribution of Annual Giving patches to girl members
- Assists with identification of potential community donors
- Recommends individuals for awards at end of year and participates in the year-end evaluation
- Assists Volunteer & Troop support to recruit new members to the Annual Giving
- Requests support from the Fund Development Department as needed
